Our ring sizes are consistent with what you'd find at your local jewelry store. For your convenience, we have provided several options for determining accurate ring size.



IMPORTANT: When printing please make sure that you do not have page scaling selected. DO NOT SELECT "Shrink oversized pages to fit paper size" or "Expand small pages to fill paper size." Even with proper settings, some printers may vary in scale. To confirm proper size, measure the following two-inch rule with a tape measure or ruler to make sure your print is true to size.



OPTION 1- DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE USING A RING THAT FITS YOU

Lay a ring that is the correct size over the circles below making sure that the inside of your ring lines up with the outside of the circle. If you are between sizes, please order the next size larger.



OPTION 2 - DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE USING FINGER MEASUREMENT

Measure a ring that fits you (or your intended recipient):

Start by wrapping a narrow strip of paper around the knuckle of the appropriate finger. *Pull snugly!* Place a mark on the strip where it meets the end. Lay strip on chart at point "X." Number at the mark is your ring size. If the mark is between two sizes, order the next larger size.
